Winter Warming

Winter warming shelters offer overnight shelter for unsheltered neighbors during frigid weather. Winter warming shelter is activated when the temperatures are at or below 35 degrees overnight.

The City of Atlanta activates winter warming from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am at three main locations:

Central Park Recreation Center
