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COORDINATED ENTRY ACCESS POINTS


What is Coordinated Entry?


Coordinated Entry is a streamlined system that assesses households using an objective tool that identifies vulnerability and barriers to housing. Homeless service access points allow individuals to be assessed and prioritized for available housing programs as vacancies occur, based on vulnerability and severity of needs. Currently, the CoC uses the VI-SPDAT to prioritize referrals to housing interventions through coordinated entry. Within the Atlanta Continuum of Care, there are stationary access points where clients can get assessed for coordinated entry on a first come, first serve basis. Mobile assessments are performed by local PATH and outreach teams for those in unsheltered locations.

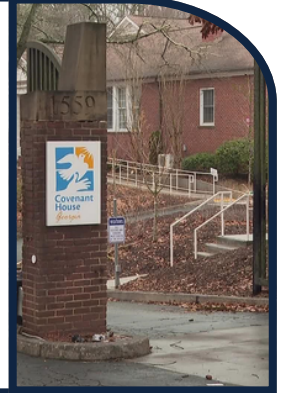

What is Street Outreach? ([HUD Exchange](#))

Street outreach activities are designed to meet the immediate needs of people experiencing homelessness in **unsheltered** locations by connecting them with emergency shelter, housing, or critical services, and providing them with urgent, non-facility-based care.

Component Services:

- Client engagement.
- Emergency health and mental health services.
- Case management.
- Transportation.
