

SUMMARY OF HUD FY2017 CoC NOFA SCORING

As the Collaborative Applicant for the Atlanta Continuum of Care (CoC), Partners for HOME is responsible for organizing, collecting, and submitting the CoC Consolidated Application for the FY2017 CoC funding. This includes the CoC Application, the CoC Priority Listing, and the new and renewal project applications, completed by the respective agencies.

Additionally, HUD has also provided guidance on how projects ranked in Tier Two will be scored. A general breakdown of those criteria is also below.
