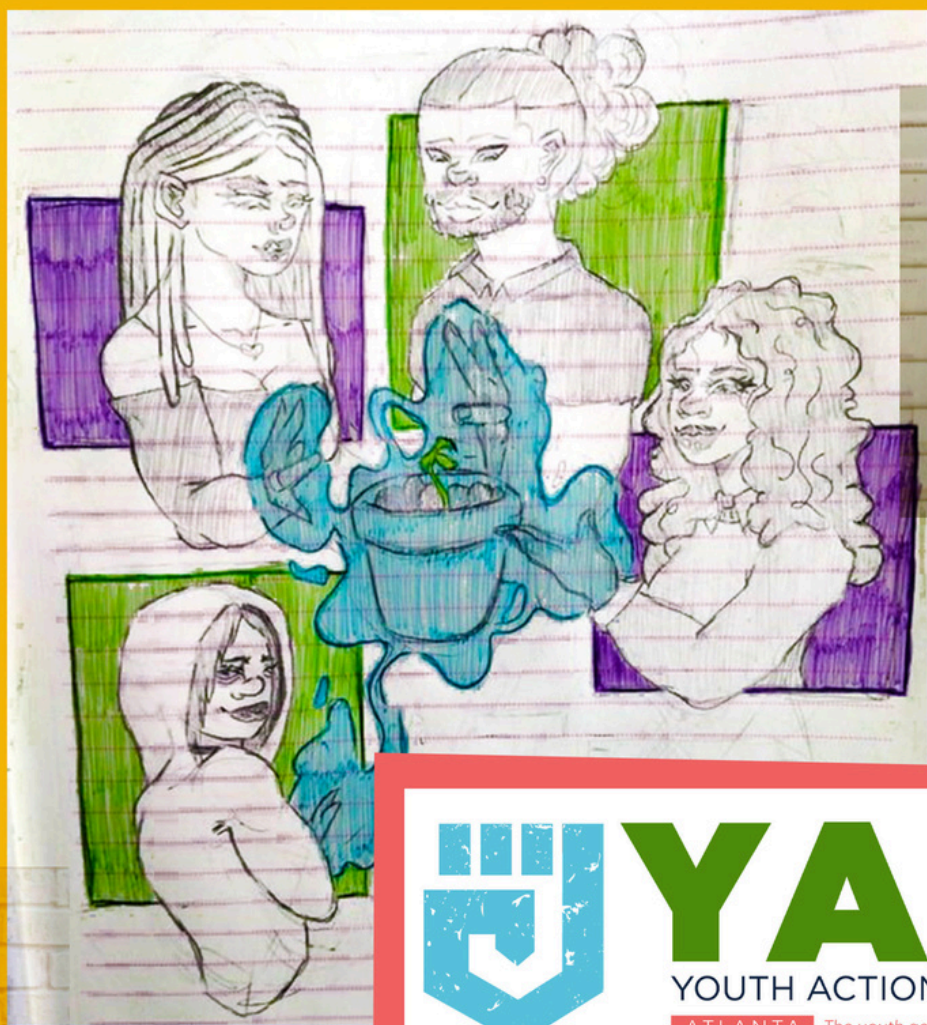

# COORDINATED ENTRY

## What is it?

Coordinated Entry is a streamlined process designed to ensure that individuals and families experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness can access the necessary housing and supportive services as efficiently as possible. This approach is particularly important for homeless youth, as it helps to prioritize those with the most urgent needs and allocate resources effectively.

## How can it help?

For homeless youth in Atlanta, the Coordinated Entry system may include partnerships with local shelters, healthcare providers, educational institutions, and employment services. Youth can be assessed through various access points, such as youth drop-in centers, hotlines, or outreach programs. The goal is to quickly identify their needs and connect them with appropriate housing and supportive services to stabilize their living situation and support their transition to independence.

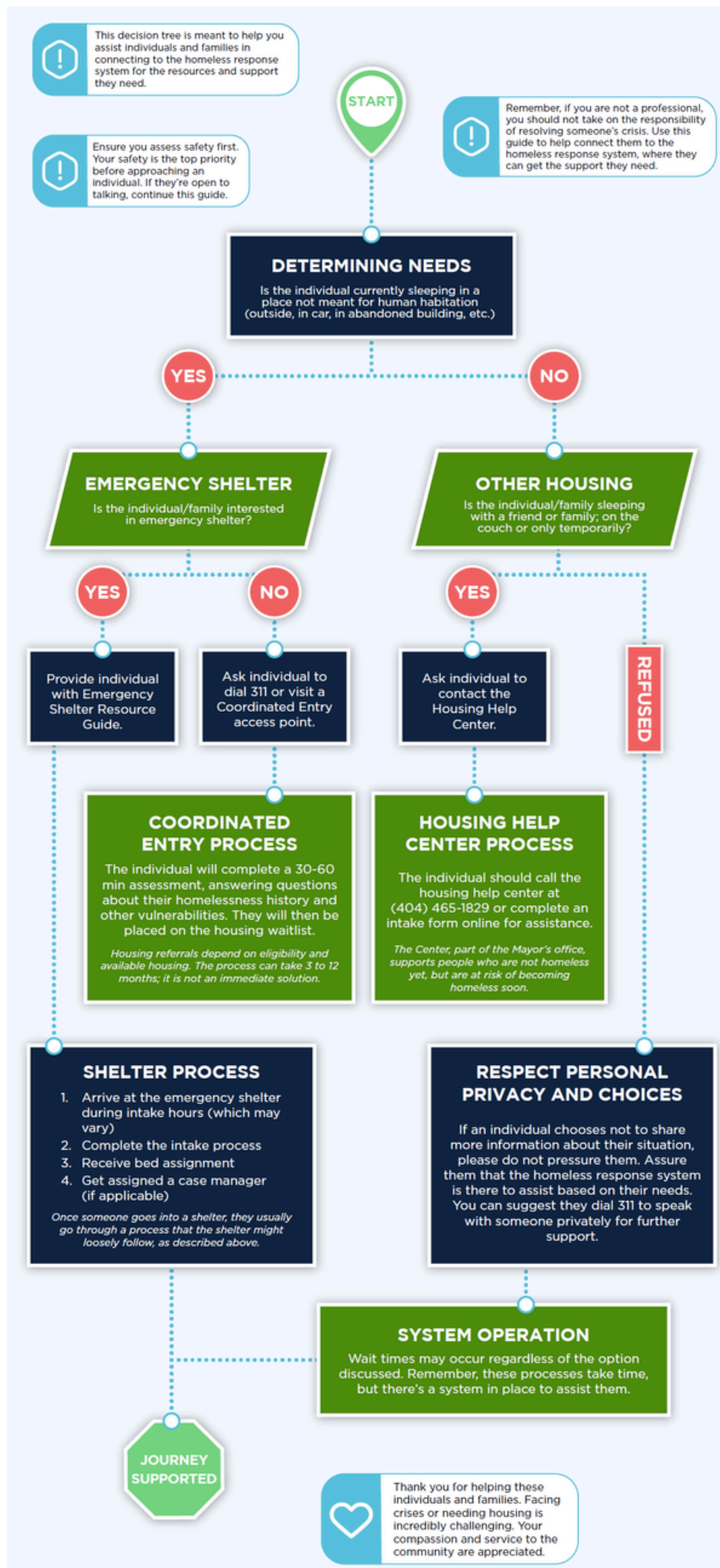

## Documents to Have on Hand:

While every shelter program/service provider has different requirements or intake protocol it never hurts to have the following on hand and readily available

- Valid Photo ID/License
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate

## Top Things to Mention or Ask Providers:

- Age
- # of children (if applicable)
- Health/Special Needs
- Employment Status

## General Emergency & Long-term Shelter Reminders:

- 2 bags of personal items
