So, what is this NOFO thing???

- The US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) releases federal resources for homeless programming and housing to communities across the country through the Continuum of Care (CoC) annual (for now) competition.
 - Georgia has 9 CoCs.
 - Partners for HOME is the Collaborative Applicant for the Atlanta CoC.
 - One responsibility of PFH is to apply for the HUD CoC funding when HUD releases the **Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)**.

Who can apply?

- Renewal applicants
- New applicants
 - Nonprofits (501c3)
 - PHAs
 - Local Governments
 - And others

How Much Money?

- Depends on performance of CoC
- FY23, about \$12.5mil for Atlanta CoC
- For new projects?
 - Potential bonus funds
 - Reallocation

What can this funding be used for?

- Caveat
 - Projection
 - HUD has not released NOFO yet
- Permanent Housing
 - Rapid Rehousing
 - Permanent Supportive Housing



CoC Rapid Rehousing – in brief

- Tenant based rental assistance and
 - Short (up to three months)
 - Medium (4 – 24 months)
- Supportive services

CoC Permanent Supportive Housing – in brief

- Long term housing and
 - Rental assistance
 - Leasing
- Supportive services
- At least one member of household has a disability



Other General Info about CoC NOFO Project Requirements

- CoC participation
- Coordinated Entry participation
- Housing First
- Equal Access
- HMIS participation
- Connection to mainstream services
- Demonstration of sound financial management
- 25% match



What's the Process?

- Local competition
 - Renewal applications and new applications scored, ranked and voted on by Governing Council
- CoC Consolidated Application
 - Project applications
 - Priority list
 - CoC application
 - Coordinated Entry participation
- Long wait
- Awards announced
- Typically longer wait for new contracts to be executed
- New projects started and people housed!
