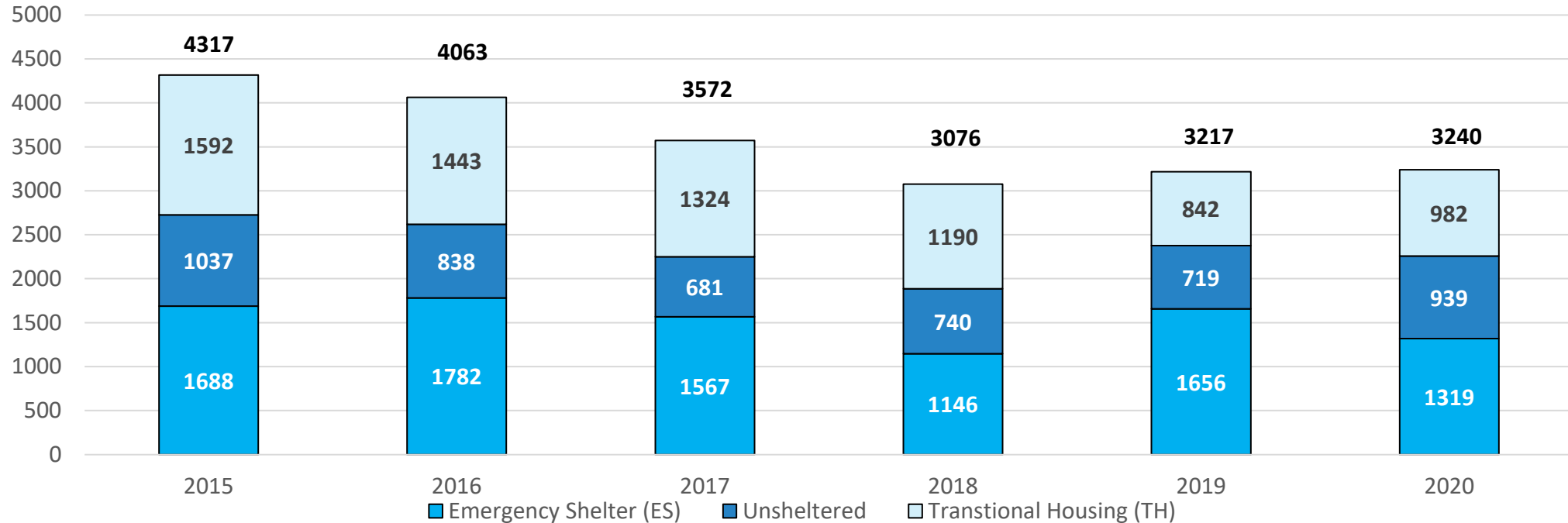
One Project at a Time...

Project Types

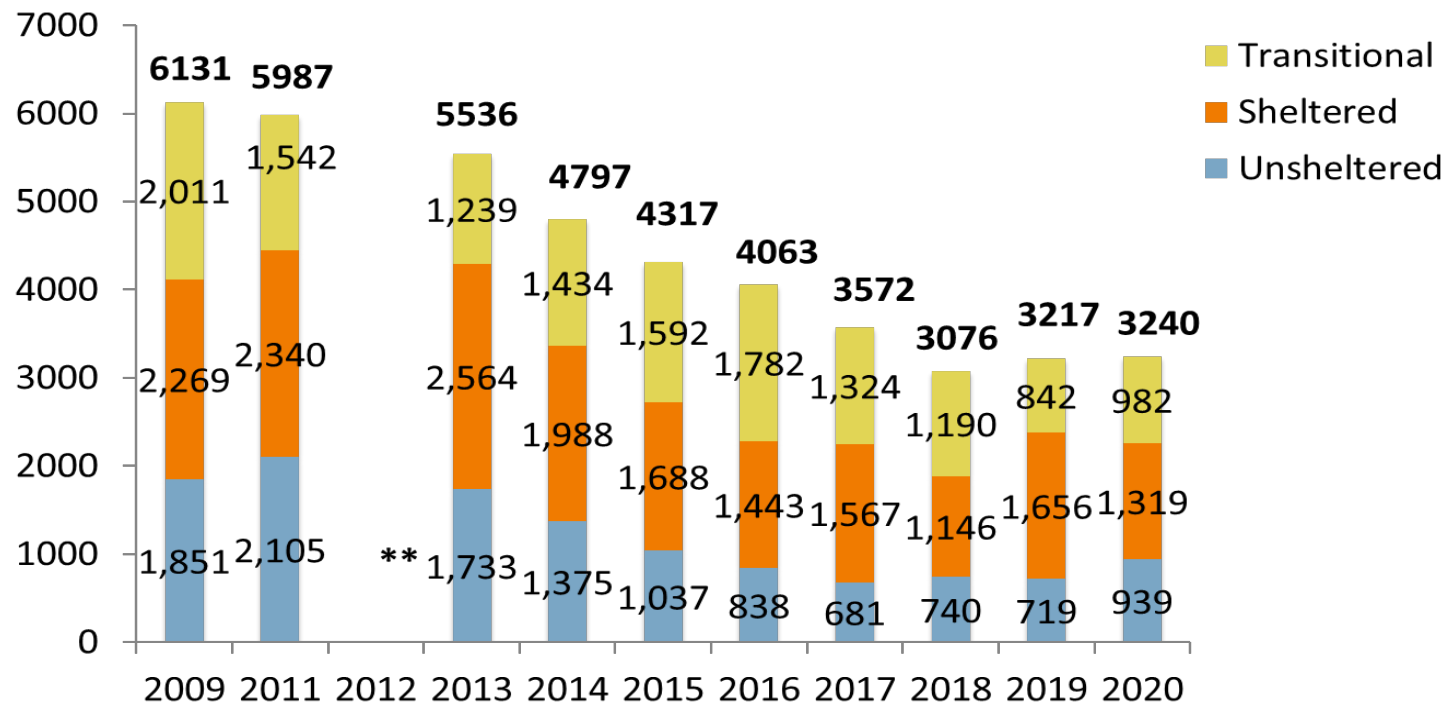
- ✓ Emergency Shelter
 - ✓ From TH to ES (2)
 - ✓ Overflow beds tracked in separate projects for Atlanta Mission
- ✓ Transitional Housing
 - ✓ Faith based projects operate transitional housing differently
 - ✓ Atlanta Mission, MSH project type change from ES to TH (92)

Since 2009, the total population has decreased by 47% but recent years have seen a slight uptick in the total population and large increase in the unsheltered.

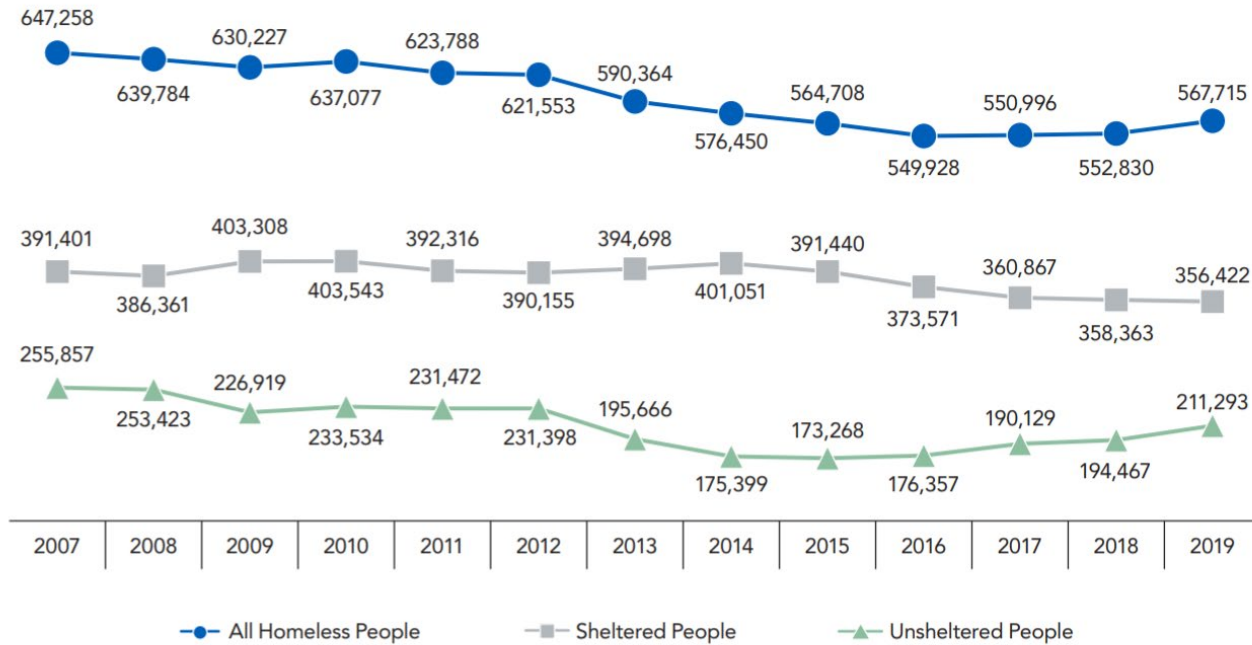

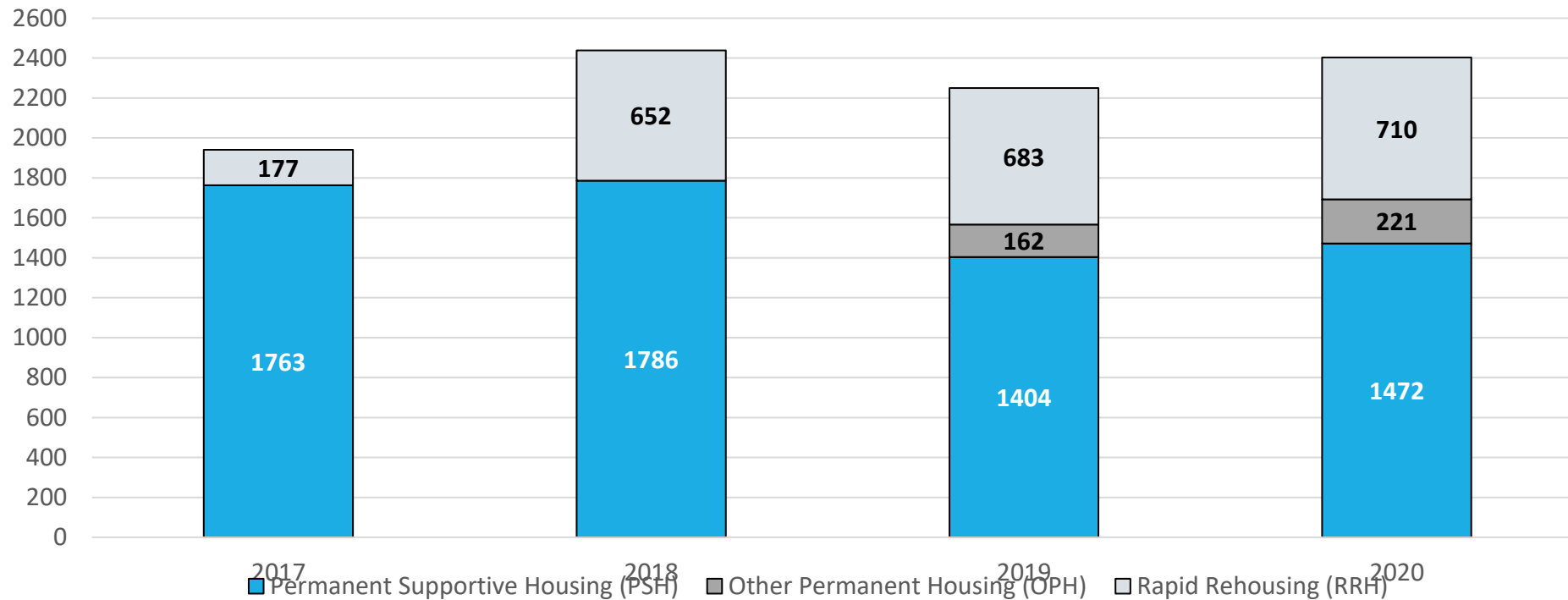

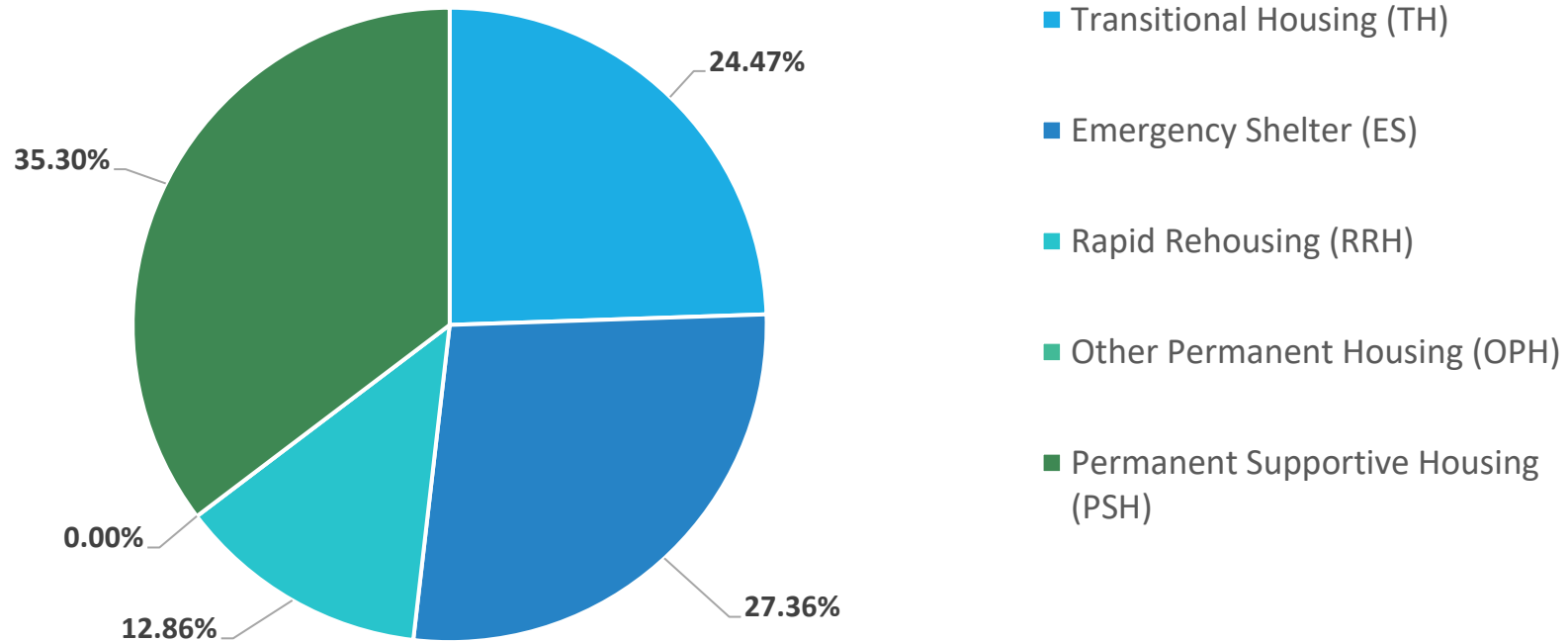
EXHIBIT 1.1: PIT Estimates of People Experiencing Homelessness
By Sheltered Status, 2007–2019



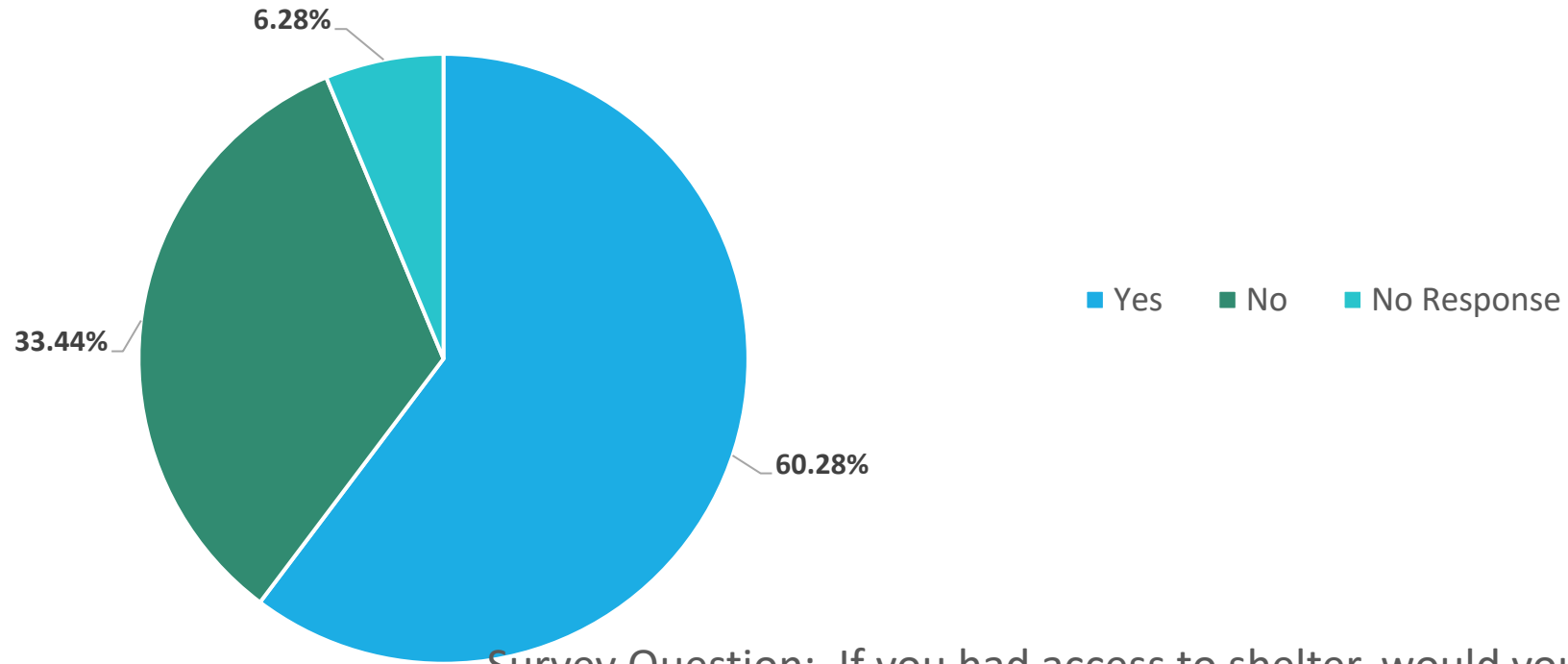
Housed by Project Type Totals



2020 Housing / Beds Available



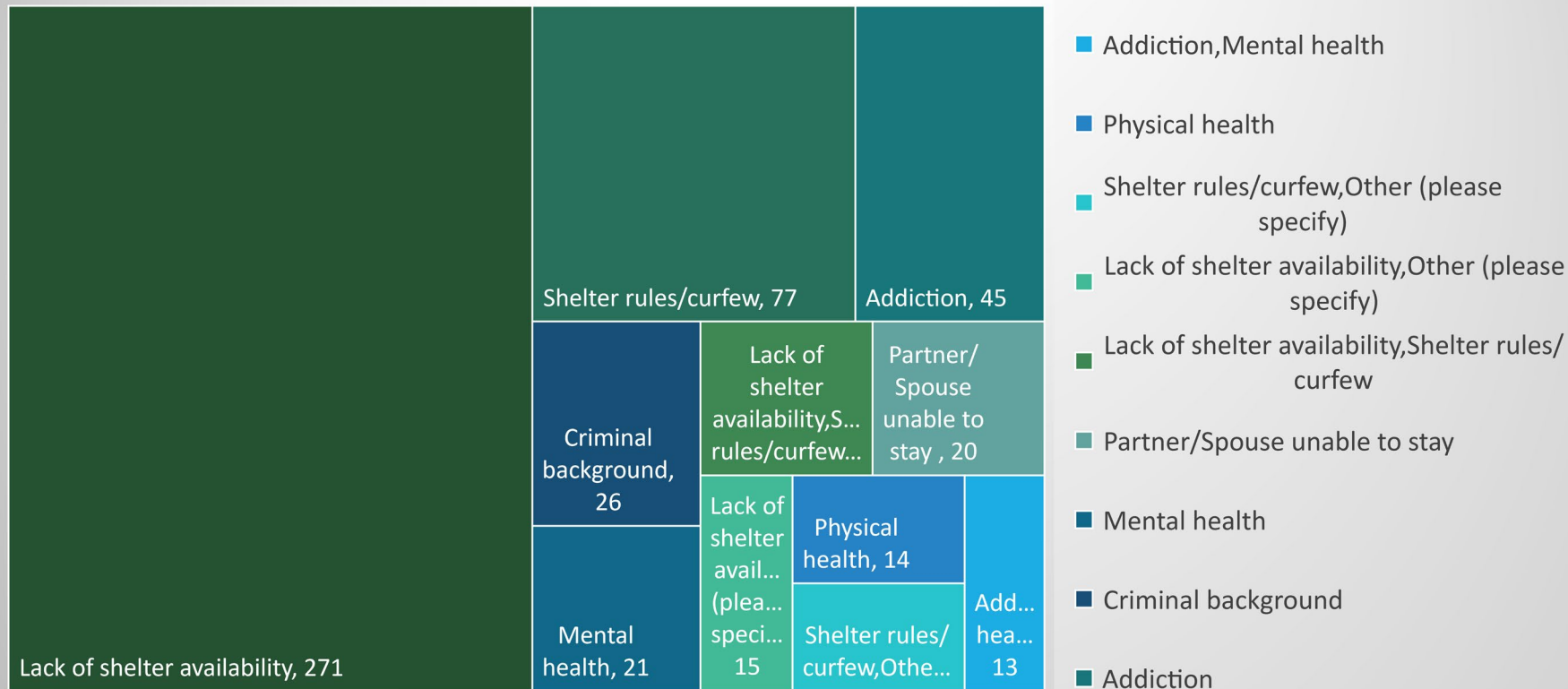
2020 Unsheltered Access to Shelter



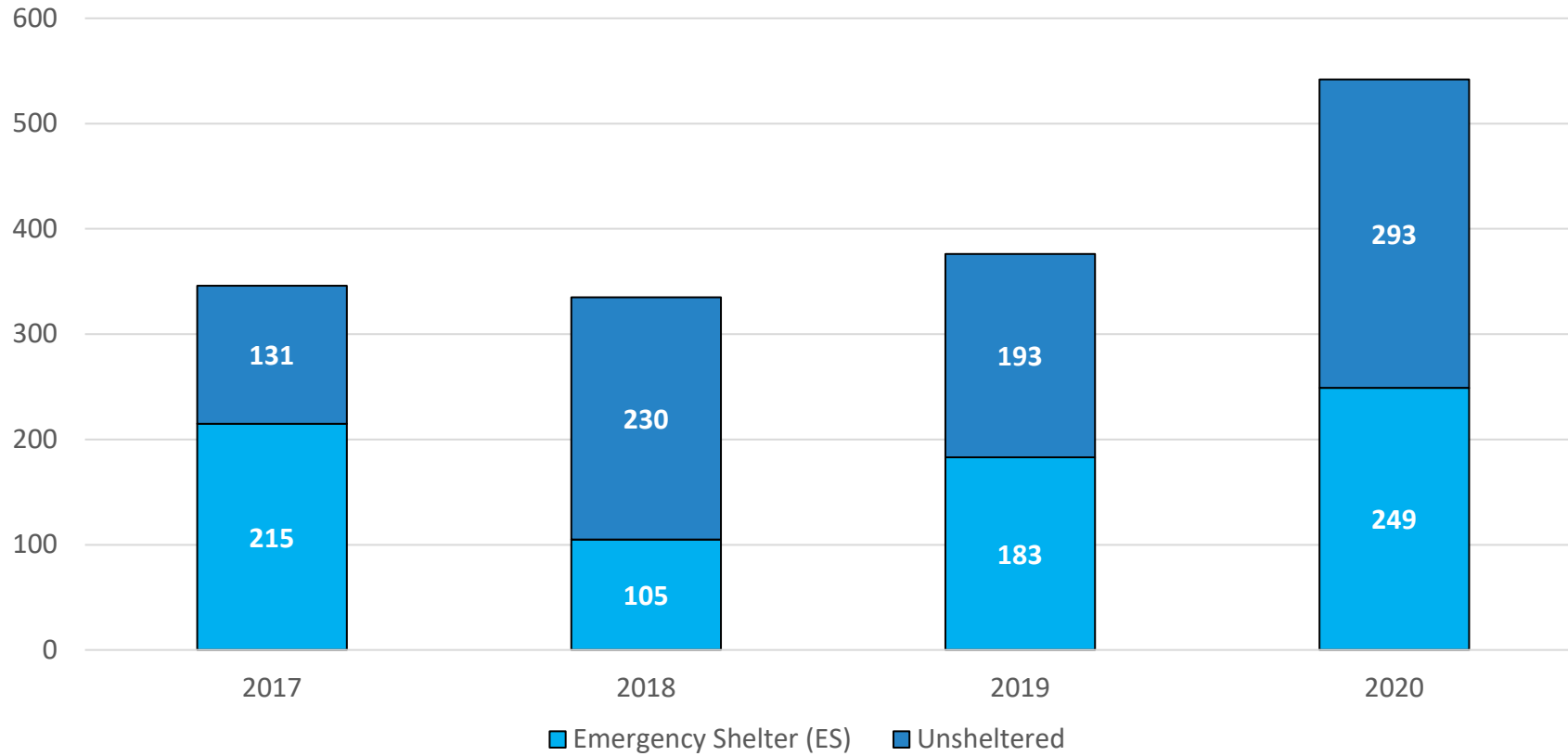
Survey Question: If you had access to shelter, would you go?

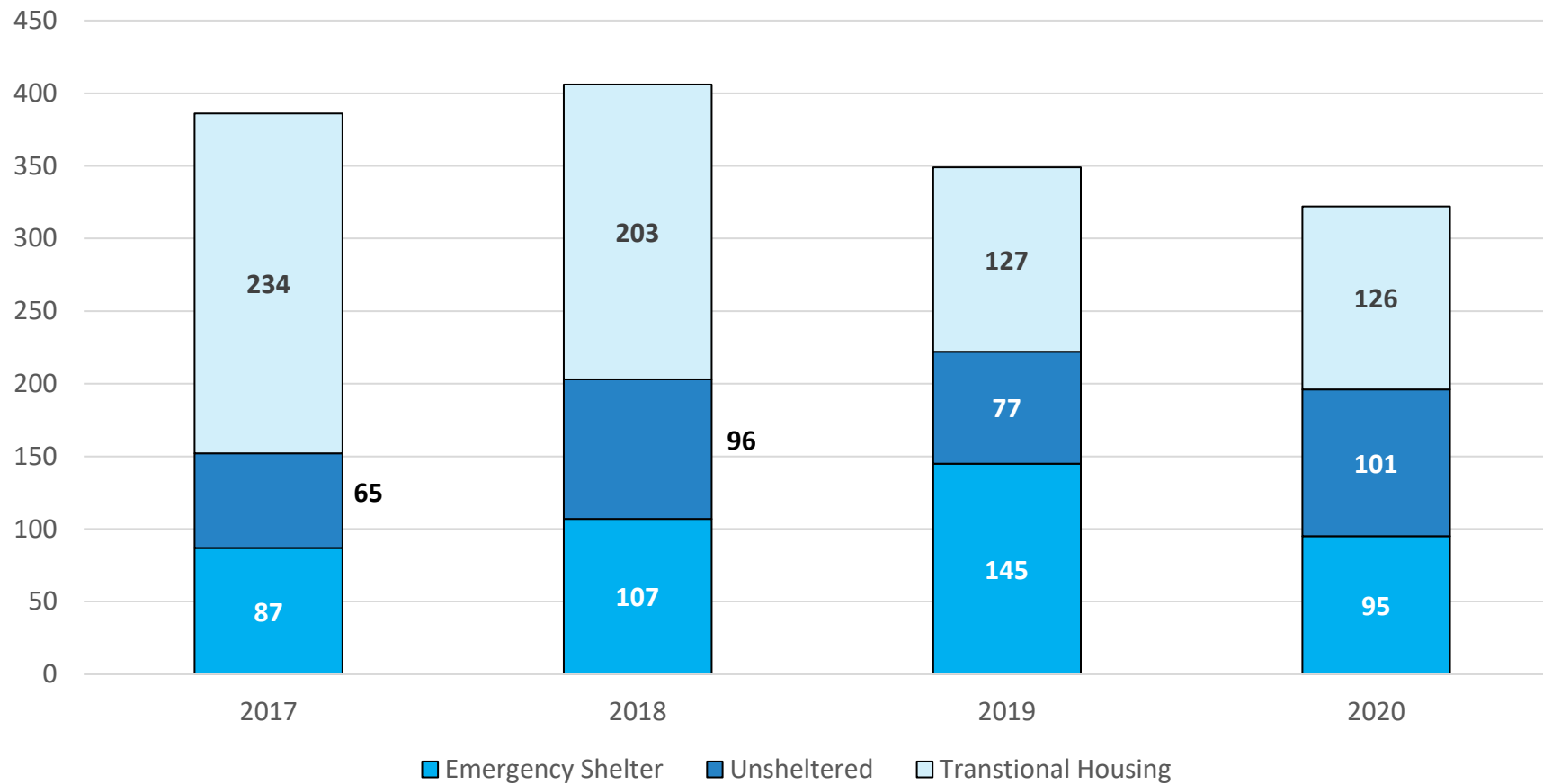
Survey Question: Why are you sleeping outside tonight?



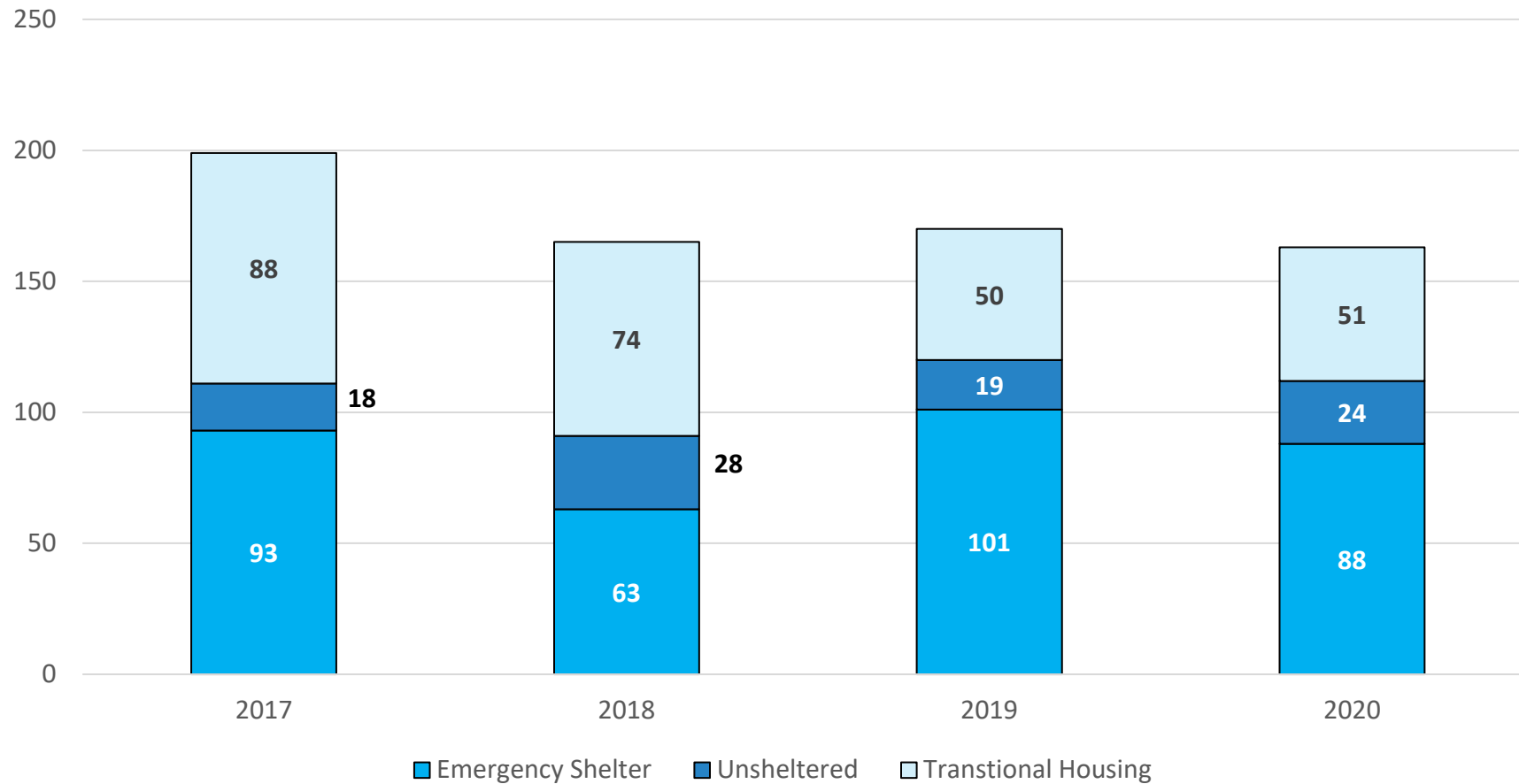
Chronic Population PIT Totals



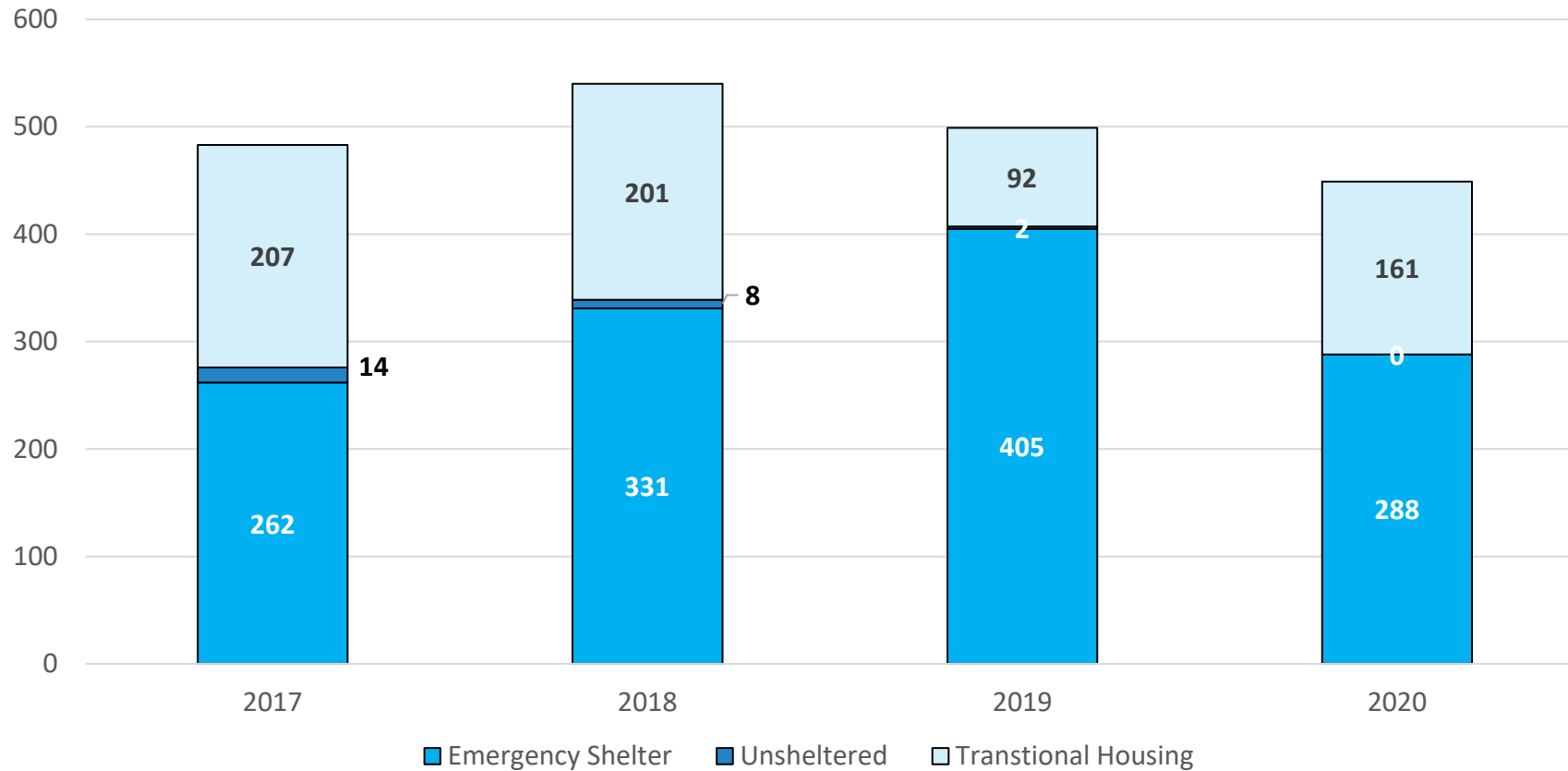
Veteran PIT Population



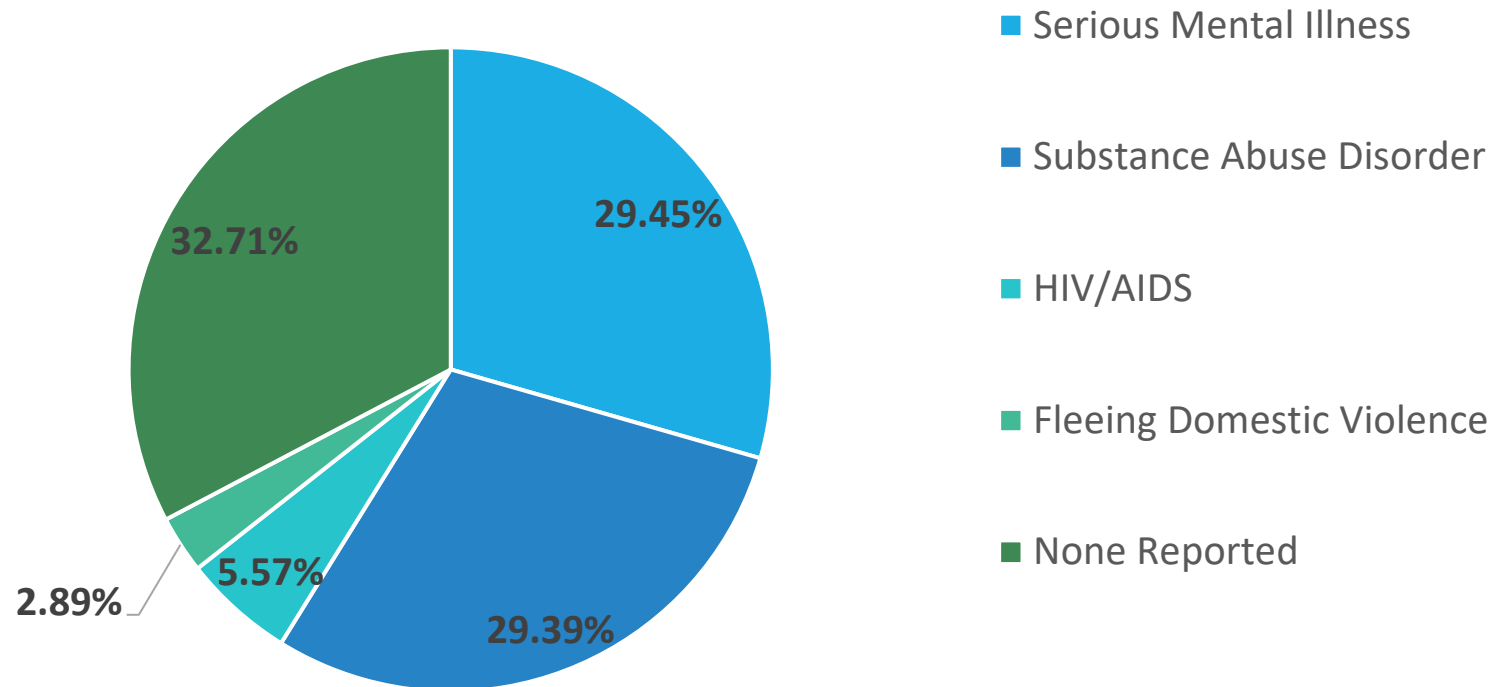
Youth PIT Population



Adults with Children PIT Population

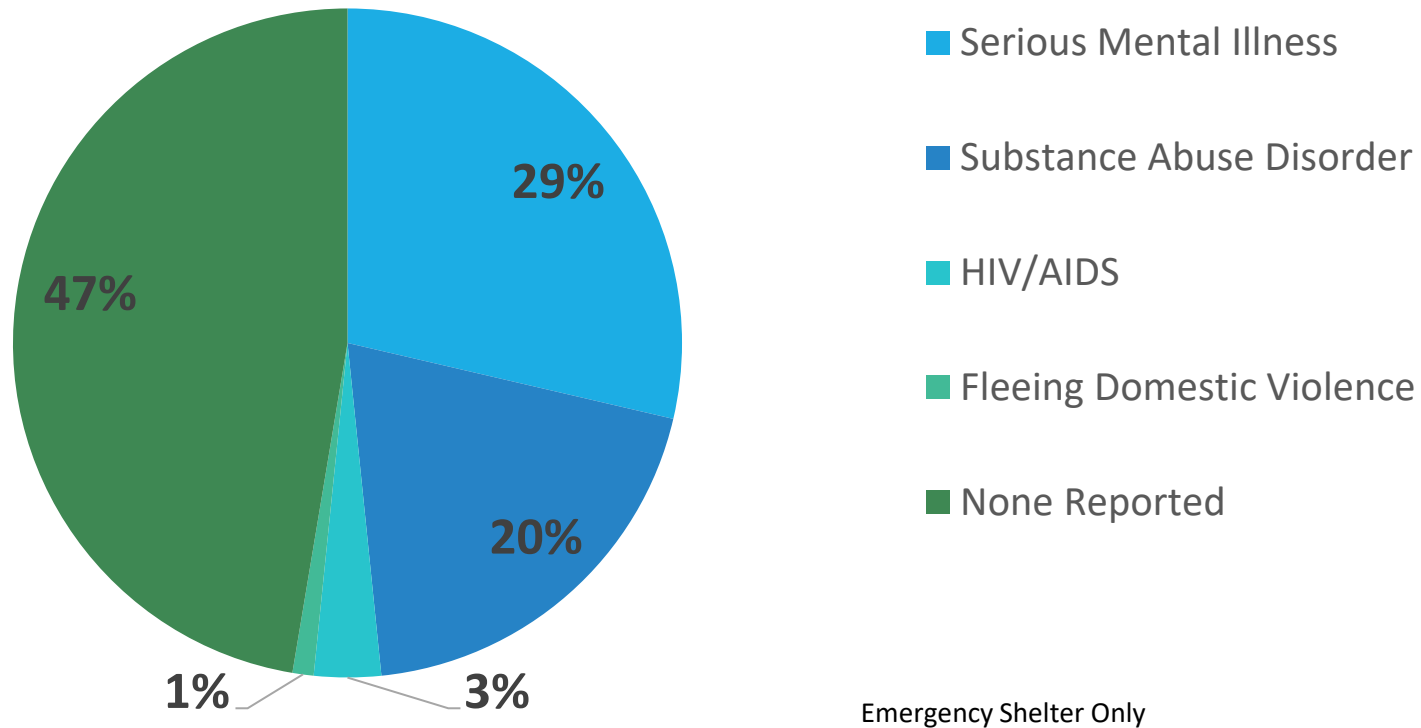

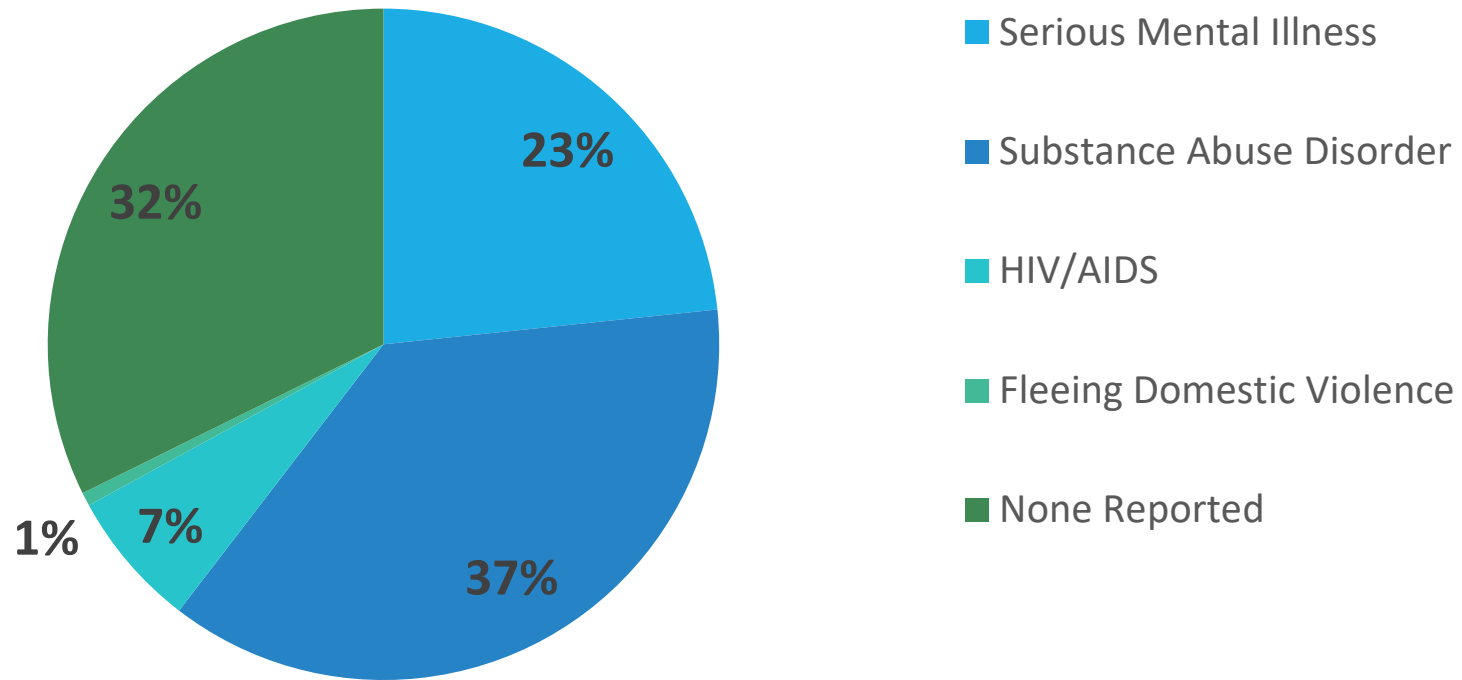

2020 Subpopulations ES



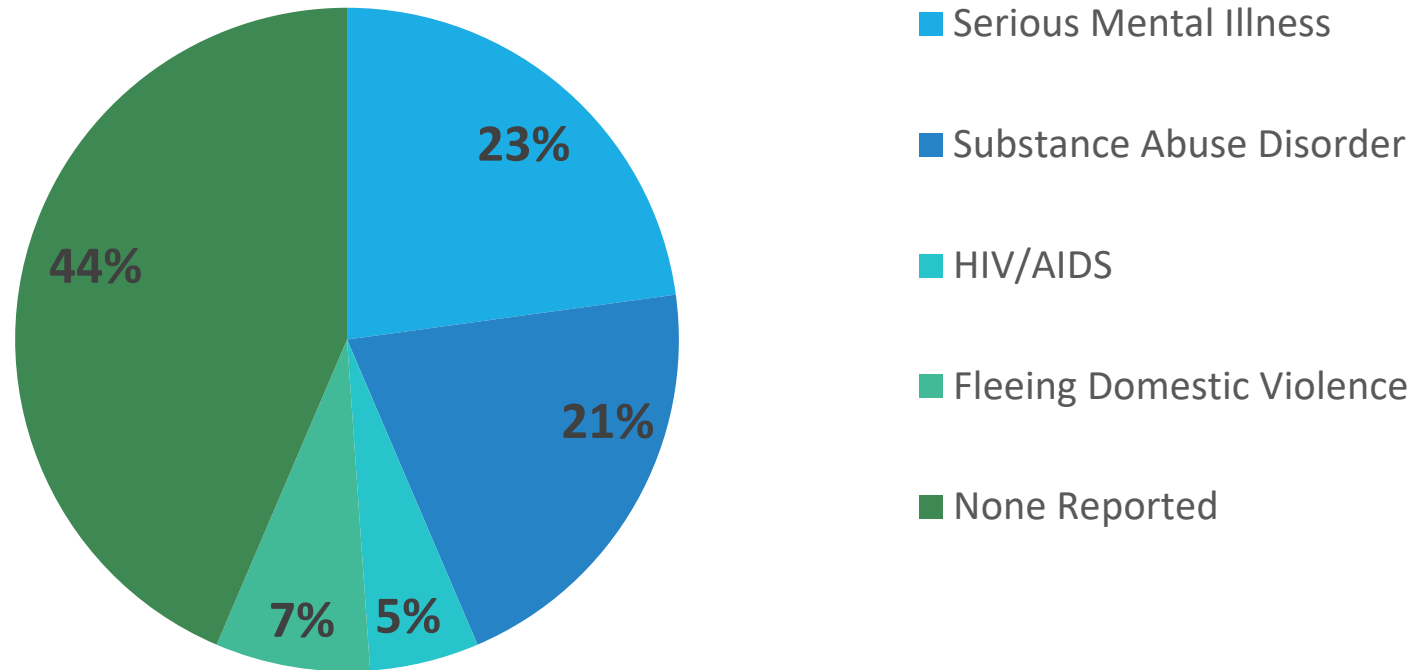
Emergency Shelter Only

2020 Subpopulations TH



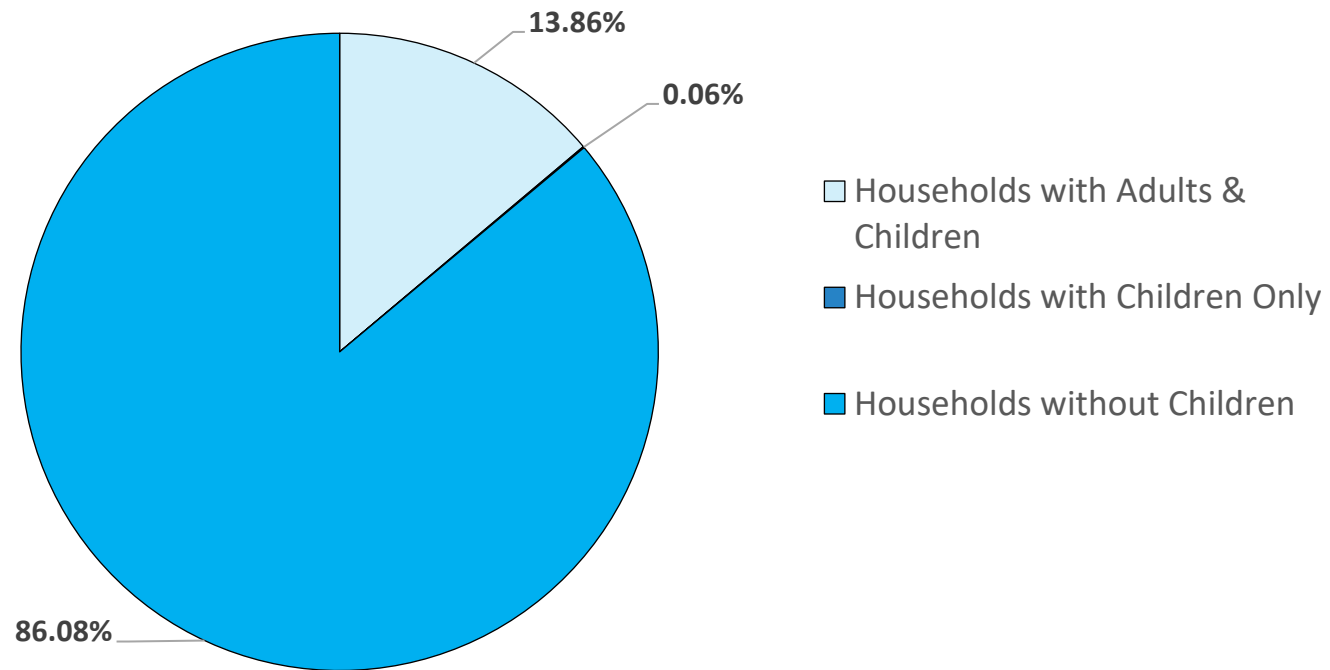
Transitional Housing Only

2020 Subpopulations Unsheltered



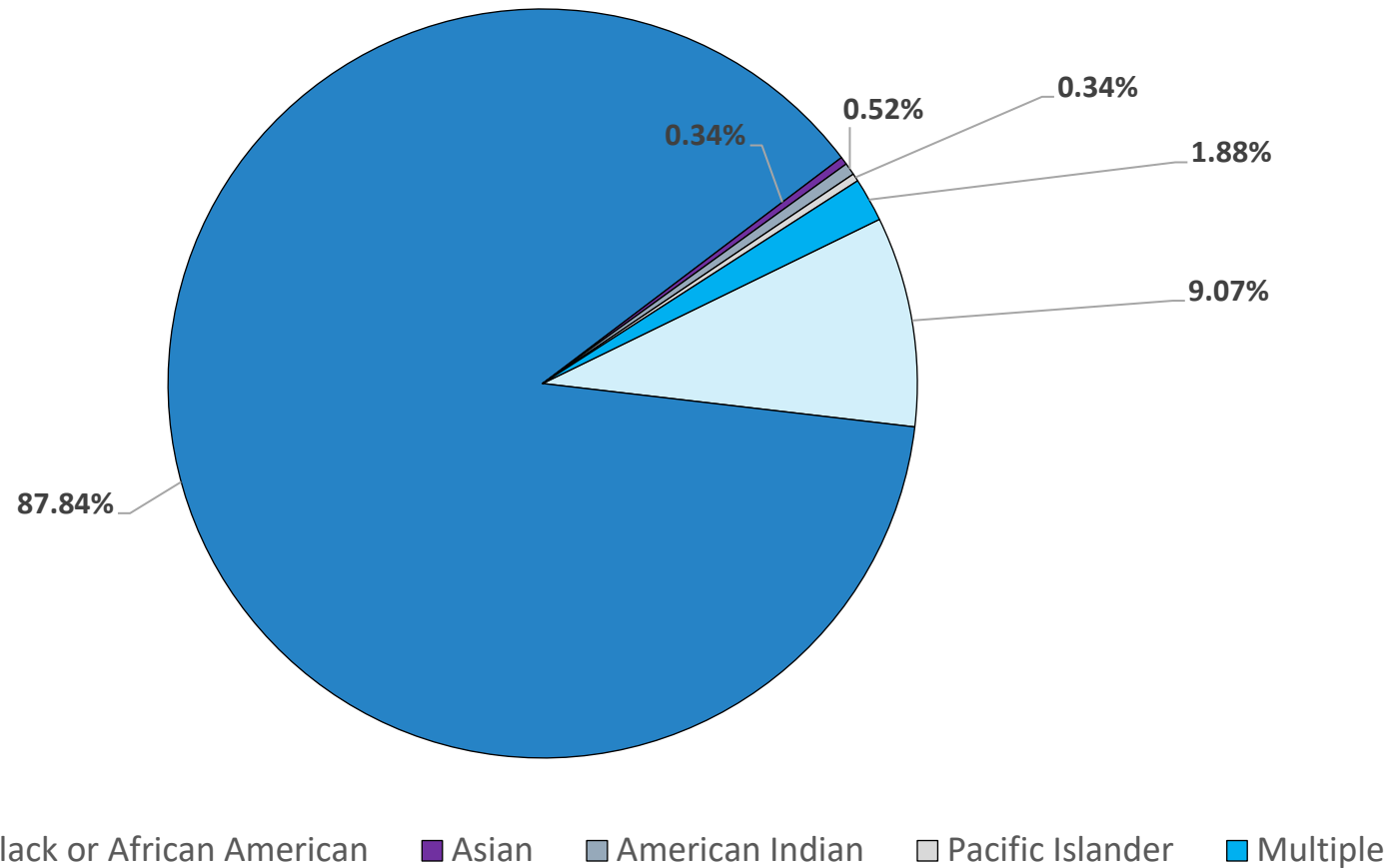
Unsheltered Only

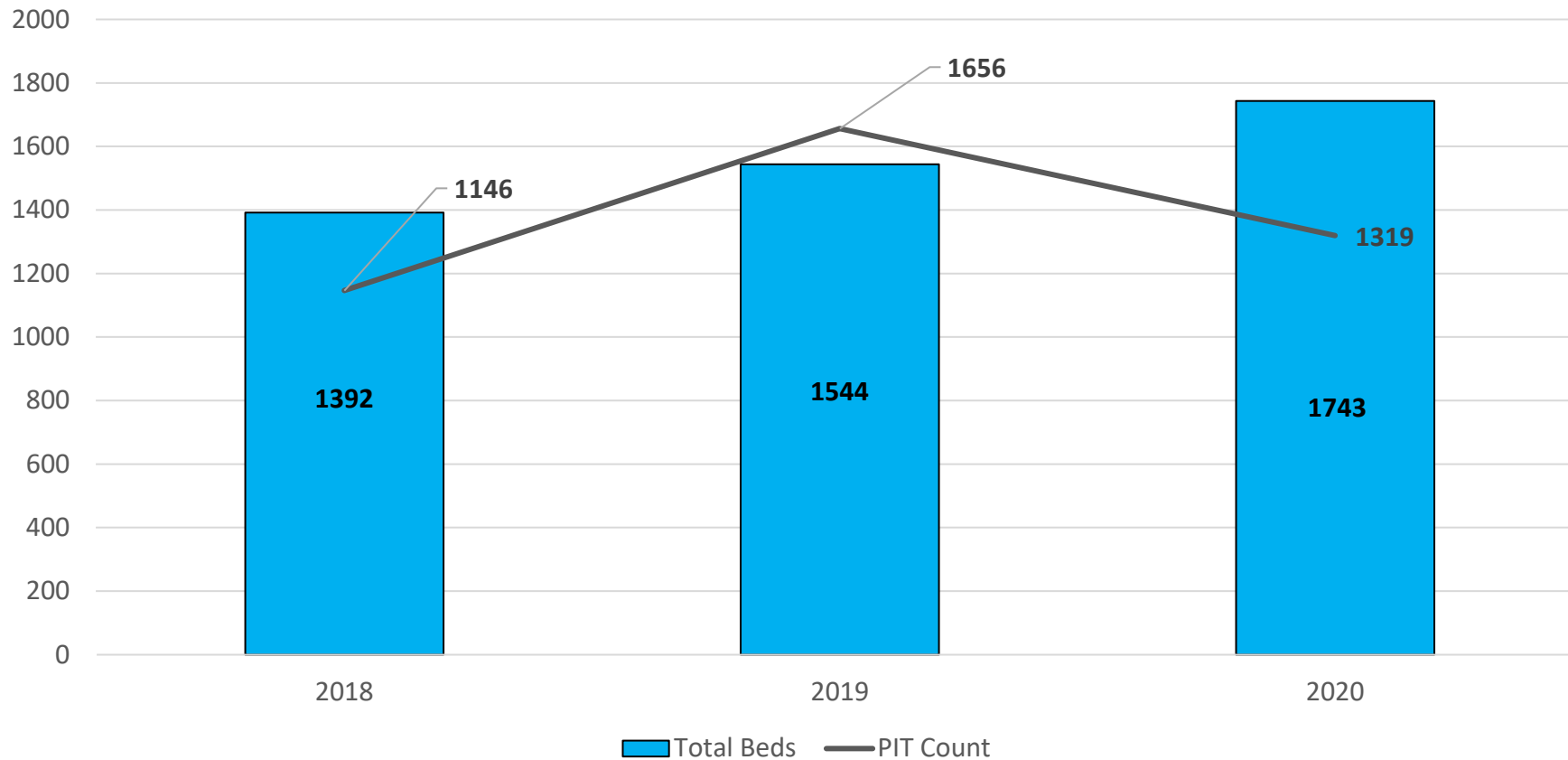

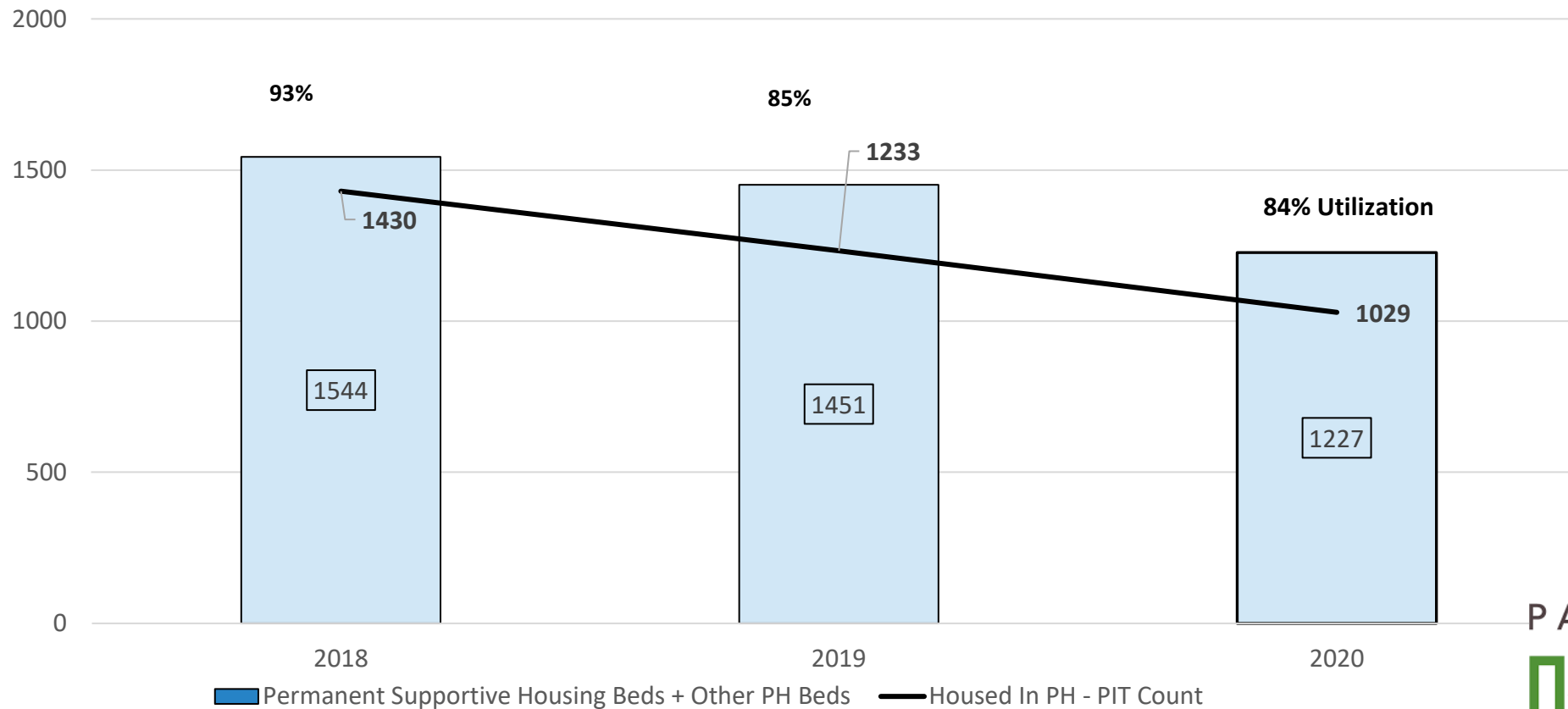
HIC: Emergency Shelter Beds



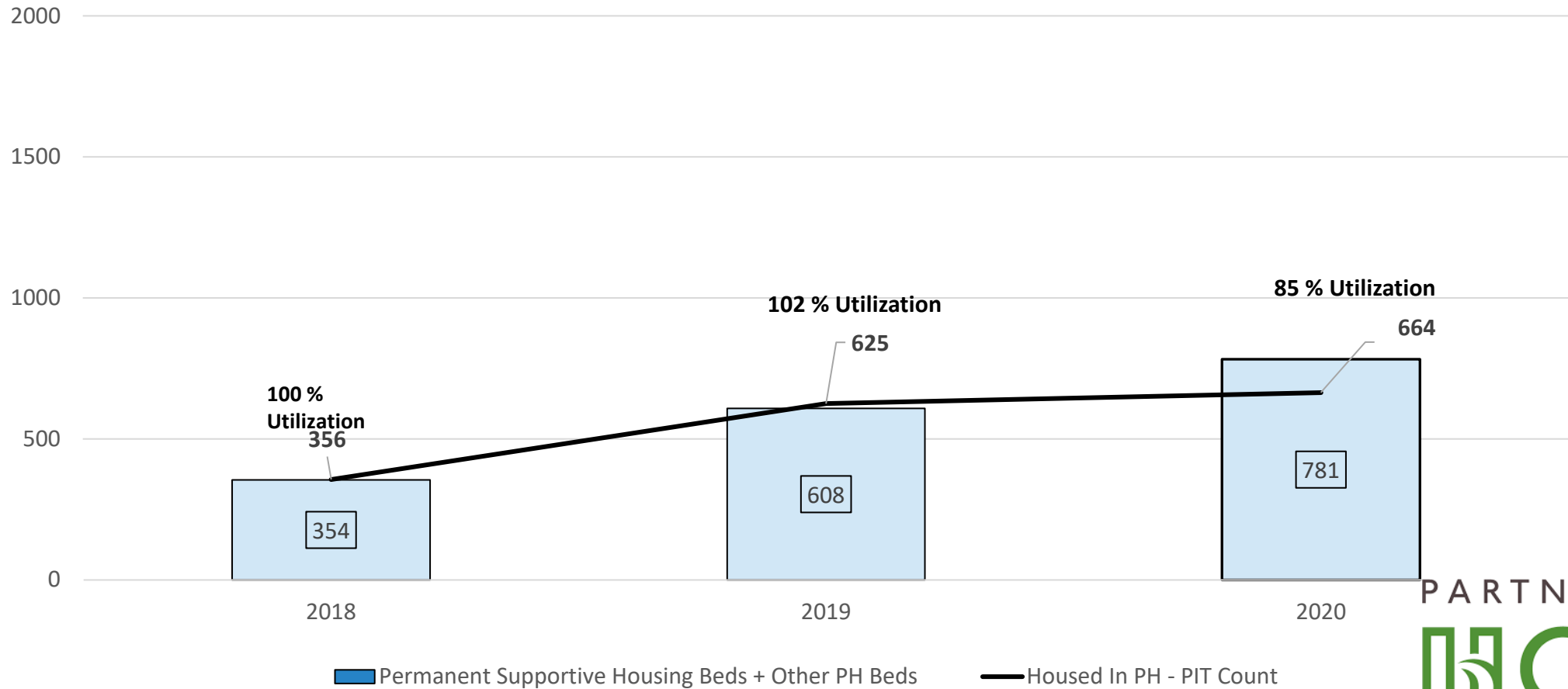
HIC: Transitional Housing Beds

- Housing Utilization
 - Inventory changes over time
 - Clients without housing move-in dates (enrolled but not moved in)
- Vacancy Management comparisons

Conclusions and Policy

- Utilization
 - Perception of barriers to entry
 - Underutilization
- Investment in RRH and PSH
- Disability and timing into Chronicity
- Dedicated and consistent street outreach response to increases

Next year...

- Web Portal for Housing Inventory Count and Point in Time
 - Improvement in data quality
 - Ease of access for providers
 - Removes need to schedule an appointment with ICA to report numbers
- PSH Pipeline Projects will be online with Housed Clients
- Continued improvement in project descriptor data quality and client data quality
