POLICE ALTERNATIVE AND
DIVERSION INITIATIVE

Assistance for non-emergency issues related to mental health, substance use or extreme poverty within the City of Atlanta. A team will travel to the area and attempt to provide immediate assistance.

Call 9-1-1

EMERGENCY TELEPHONE

Medical, property and criminal resource for emergencies that require response from an EMT, the fire department or police.

Coordinated Entry is the system that assesses a household for shelter and housing services. If you know someone experiencing homelessness, contact Gateway Center first to get an assessment for Coordinated Entry.
