

Echo Healing Center & Residences Q&A

1. Q: Is the expectation that supportive services be provided 7 days/week?
A: This is the ideal model; however, the final service schedule will depend on the available budget.
2. Q: What percentage of units at the site will transition to PSH?
A: After five years, 42 units will transition to PSH, while 18 units will remain as non-congregate shelter.
3. Q: Will there be additional permanent housing resources that this project would be prioritized for to achieve the 60-75% exits to permanent destinations?
A: No additional permanent housing resources have been identified at this time.
4. Q: Is there an identified target population for this project in addition to those that are HOME ARP eligible?
A: No. Due to HOME-ARP policies we cannot add additional target populations.
5. Q: Who are the referring partners for this project and are there any referring partners whose referrals would be prioritized?
A: We are currently establishing a referral partnership with ViewPoint Health. We are also in discussions with Grady Hospital and Hearts to Nourish Hope regarding potential referral partnerships.
